Outline: The Playford Trust has allocated up to four scholarships for each of the three universities (i.e. Adelaide University, Flinders University and the University of South Australia), to support students intending to undertake an Honours Program; with the nominated students to be spread across the following priority areas:

- Horticulture and Aquaculture
- Water, Energy and Climate Change
- Advanced Manufacturing and New Technologies
- Mining and Resources Development

Nomination Process: The Playford Trust calls for four nominations to be made by each of the three universities for the consideration of the Trust. It is expected that the universities will select the highest calibre students through an internal process that takes account of the selection criteria given below. The Trust reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the nominations made if it considers that such nominees do not reflect the objectives of the Trust or do not meet the high standards that are consistent with the status of this award. The Scholarship Sub-Committee of the Board of the Playford Trust will make the final selection.

Please note: It is important that all the information requested is provided to assist in the selection process. Failure to do so may mean that the nominee or applicant will not be fully considered. Where universities are making the nomination of a student it is considered important to obtain a personal statement from the student regarding aspirations for the future with respect to career goals or further study intentions. Similarly, the student should respond to the information request on extra curricular activities such as sport or community activities. It is also important to have some information on the likely project to be undertaken in the Honours program. It is recognized that in some cases a final decision on the project may not be made by the closing date for these scholarship nominations. However, some discussion of the likely project options is required to assist the assessment process.

Disclosure of any other awards or scholarships held by the nominees is also required.
